## World News

The war between Russia and the Ukraine continues. On the evening of November 25-26, Russia launched an estimated 188 drones into the Ukraine [1]. Then, on the morning of December 13, Russian forces launched a major attack directed against the Ukrainian energy facilities [2]. This comes as reports indicate North Korean troops are involved in mass assaults against Ukrainian forces [3]. In Syria, rebel forces challenged the government. For instance, on November 30, the city of Aleppo fell to rebel forces [4]. Then the Islamist group Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS), captured another city, Hama [5]. Meanwhile, there are indications that Turkey's President Erdogan was cheering on the rebels and may have supported the uprising [6]. Next, Syrian President Assad was toppled by the rebels [7]. One report indicates Turkish forces are inside Northern Syria [8].

Meanwhile, China continues its aggressive tactics. Case in point, Taiwan detected 47 planes and a dozen ships near the island nation [9]. China is not disclosing the reason for its current military actions [10].

# Israel War

This news cycle began with Hezbollah firing approximately 250 rockets into Israel [1]. Meanwhile, a Shakey cease-fire between Israel and Hezbollah was agreed to [2].

While the cease-fire looked good on the news, it showed signs of collapse. Case in point, there were violations of the agreement including Israeli airstrikes [3]. The violations continued to include drone and artillery attacks [4].

Syria fell to rebel forces [5]. Immediately, Israel started operations against Syria capturing some Syrian land [6]. Additionally, after the fall, the US stuck approximately 75 ISIS targets in Syria [7]. After Israeli forces destroyed the Syrian navy, approximately 480 targets were struck over a two-day period [8]. The collapse of Syria was a major blow to Hezbollah including cutting off many weapons supply routs [9].

he stock market indexes continued to rise. On November 26, the NASDAQ, S&P 500, and DJIA indexes closed at record highs [1]. Then on November 29, both the DJIA and the S&P 500 closed at record highs [2]. On December 2 and 3, the NASDAQ and S&P 500 both closed at record highs [3,4]. On December 4, the three indexes closed at record highs with the DIIA breaking through the 45,000 level [5]. Then, on December 6, the S&P 500 and NASDAO closed at record highs [6].

The annual Consumer Price Index (CPI) came in at 2.7% [7]. Following the CPI report, the NASDAQ rose on December 11 to a new record high closing above 20,000 [8].
