## World News

The leader of Iran died in a helicopter crash [1]. Meanwhile, a Marshall Islands-flagged ship was stuck in the Red Sea and is taking on water [2]. In response, the U.S. and Britain fighter jets struck 13 Houthi targets in Yemen [3]. According to Houthis sources, at least 16 people died in the attacks [4].

The world is seeing an increase of military arms and planning for the future. Case in point, Inda has determined it requires a third aircraft carrier [5].

Meanwhile, Russia continues to enhance its military capabilities. For instance, the US believes Russia launched a counter space weapon [6]. Some have suggested that Russian satellite Cosmos 2553, launched in 2022, may also have a nuclear device [7]. Additionally, one report indicates Russia has deployed a jamming capability that renders the new US-supplied HIMARS rocket launchers ineffective [8]. Moreover, President Biden gave approval for the Ukraine to use US supplied weapons for attacks on Russian soil [9]. In response, Russia claims the right to supply like weapons to Western advisories [10].

In a show of military strength, China conducted military exercises around the island nation of Taiwan [11]. China's military announced they are training to seize power [12]. In response, the US State Department announced they are concerned over the Chinese military actions [13].
