World News

In Germany, an arrest warrant was issued to a Ukrainian diving instructor for his role in blowing up the Nord Stream gas pipelines [1]. Russian officials claim such an attack would have required US approval [2]. Ukraine officials claimed the basis for the warrant was false [3].

The Ukraine land invasion appears to have taken Russia by surprise [4]. Meanwhile, the Ukrainian forces have destroyed bridges and appear to be setting up a buffer zone [5]. This comes as Russia accused the Ukraine of a 45 drone attack direct against targets in the Moscow area [6]. Elsewhere, a Ukrainian UAV attack in the town of Proletarsk, located around 150 miles from the Ukrainian border resulted in a oil depot fire [7]. On August 26, Russia launched approximately 100 drones and 100 missiles at targets within the Ukraine [8].

In Asia, China continues to expand its military capabilities. For example, China launched a new non-nuclear submarine that includes vertical launch tubes [9]. China also sent a spy plane into Japan's air space [10].

Israel War

n August 17, Israel forces struck targets in southern Lebanon prompting Hezbollah to fire 55 projectiles into Israel [1]. The Israel Air Force (IAF) targeted rocket launchers where rockets were launched [2]. Meanwhile, 2 Hezbollah missiles hit the Israel Air Force's Air Control Unit base near Mount Meron [3].

The war between Hezbollah and Israel appears to be escalating. Case in point, in one attack, Israel used over 100 fighter aircraft to strike targets in Lenabnon [4].

The Houthi rebels attacked a Greek-flagged oil tanker traveling through the Red Sea, leaving the ship drifting and ablaze [5].

In Tel Aviv, Israel, a man's explosive back pack exploded killing the man [1]. Hamas claimed responsibility for the planned suicide attack [2].

At the Democratic National Convention in Chicago, Protesters briefly broke through the erected barrier [3]. Reports indicate four people were arrested in the breach [4]. This suggests the wall and accompanying police were sufficient to protect the DNC event.

In Solingen, Germany, at least three people were killed in a stabbing attack [5]. The Islamic State claimed responsibility for the knife attack [6]. In the resort town of La Grande-Motte, France, A bomb explosion outside of a synagogue injured a police officer [7]. In south-west Pakistan, gunmen killed at least 22 people after forcing them from their vehicles and checking their IDs [8].

Inflation remains a issue but the rate of increase has slowed. Case in point, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for July fell to an annual 2.9% rate [1].

In an election year, job growth is an important selling point. However, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, there were 818,000 fewer jobs in March of this year than were initially reported [2]. Meanwhile, the stock market

indexes continued to remain strong. For example, on August 26, the Dow Jones Industrial Average (DJIA) closed at a record high {3].
