For the second time in months, a gunman tried to assassinate Donald Trump [1]. In response, the House of Representatives unanimously passed a bill to expand Secret Service protection for both parties [2].

Some are suggesting that the war in the Ukraine is consuming too many military resources and is leaving the US vulnerable to China [3]. Meanwhile, reports indicate Iran is supplying ballistic missiles to Russia [4]. Russia also launched a counter-attack on the Ukrainian forces that entered the Kursk region [5]. The Ukraine war is starting to test the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). Case in point, Latvia and Romania, two NATO member, said Russian drones violated their airspace [6]. Indeed, Vladimir Putin warned if Ukraine uses long range missiles to attack inside Russia, he would view this as an attack by NATO [7]. This comes as a Ukrainian drone attack struck a Russian depot around 230 miles north of Moscow; resulting in a massive series of explosions [8]. Additionally, Ukraine sources claimed to attack two additional depots on September 20 [9]. Finally, the second depots attacked resulted in an explosion estimated at 2,000 tons [10].

The war continues to expand to include more Hezbollah targets. For example, on September 11, the Israel Air Force struck Hezbollah targets in southern Lebanon [1]. Then on September 14, Hezbollah fired a number of rockets into Northern Israel [2].

Meanwhile, Israel is being targeted from multiple directions. For instance, Yemen fired a ballistic missile that successfully penetrated the Israel defense and impacted a few kilometers from Ben Gurion airport [3]. Israel's Prime Minister

Benjamin Netanyahu warned the Yemini Houthis that there would be a heavy price to pay for their actions [4].

On September 19, Israeli forces struck at least 52 targets in southern Lebanon [5]. Then Israel forces hit targets in Beirut, Lebanon [6]. Finally, over 100 missiles were fired into Israel on September 21 [7].
