In Yemen, US forces struck Houthis targets [1]. Reports indicate China is supplying the Houthis rebels with advanced weapons [2].

Elsewhere, Pakistan bombed targets within Afghanistan [3]. In response, Afghanistan forces are targeting Pakistan [4].

The war between Russia and the Ukraine continues. For example, Ukrainian drones struck targets hundreds of miles inside Russia [5]. What is interesting, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky predicts the war will be peacefully concluded once President Elect Trump assumes power [6]. What then was the purpose for the war?

One consequence of exporting U.S. industry to China is the dependance it creates. Case in point, after securing a near monopoly, China is now banning the elements Germanium and Gallium to the U.S. [7]. Meanwhile, reports indicate China now has a sixth-generation stealth fighter aircraft [8]. China also unveiled a 40,000-ton amphibious assault ship that can also launch fighter jets [9].

n December 16, Israeli forces struck a Syria munitions depot with their heaviest bombardment yet, setting off secondary explosions [1]. Additionally, news emerged that last September, Israeli elite forces struck, an Iranian underground missile factory located in Syria [2].

The Houthis in Yemen launched a ballistic missile into Isreal airspace [3]. In response, dozens of Israeli Air Force (IAF) aircraft struck targets withing Yemen [4]. Then another missile was fired from Yemen

that impacted in Tel Aviv [5]. On December 26, Israeli forces struck the Yemen capital Sanaa and the western city of Hodeidah [6]. This comes as the US struck Houthis targets in Yemen [7].

In Moscow, a bomb blast killed the head of Russia's nuclear and chemical forces [1]. The bomb used was hidden on an electric scooter [2]. In Magdeburg, Germany, a 50-year-old Saudi doctor plowed his car into a busy outdoor Christmas market, killing at least two people [3]. The suspect in the attack appeared in seven investigative proceedings during the two prior years [4].

In New Orleans, a driver drove a truck into a crowd killing over 10 people [5]. The attacker was identified as, Shamsud-Din Jabbar of Texas, and he had posted ISIS inspired video to social media [6]. Just prior to the vehicle-based attack, the terrorist set fire to a rented Airbnb property [7]. Then there was a Cybertruck car bomb explosion outside the Trump hotel locat-
