World News

Reports indicate that North Korea is building a nuclear-powered submarine [1]. This comes as North Korea reportedly sent another 3,000 troops to aid Russia [2].

Off the British coast, a oil tanker and a cargo vessel collided [3]. One man was arrested on suspicion of manslaughter [4]. The crushed cargo ship, the Solong, was towed to Aberdeen [5].

Meanwhile, the Ukraine launched its largest drone attack against Moscow [6]. In a separate attack, Ukraine weapons hit a strategic bomber base causing a massive explosion [7]. Meanwhile, Russia struck the city of Odesa with drones [8]. On the good news front, Russia and the Ukraine have agreed to a naval ceasefire in the Back sea [9].

In Germany, the foreign intelligence service, the BND, concluded COVID-19 was likely the result of a lab leak [10]. The finding has a confidence of 80-90% [11].

n March 15, President Trump ordered military strikes on Yemen's capital, Sanaa [1,2]. This comes as the Houthis continue to launch attacks directed against Israel [3]. Reports indicate the strikes against the Houthis are continuing [4].

Meanwhile, the ceasefire between Israel and Hamas is falling apart. Case in point, Israel military forces struck the Gaza killing over 320 people [5]. This was followed with continued bombardment as Israel demands the return of its hostages [6].

Israel forces also bombed targets in Lebanon [7]. This was followed with strikes against targets located in southern Beirut [8].

In Pakistan, the Baloch Liberation Army militant group, attacked a train and captured hostages [1]. During the first day, Pakistan's military battles the militants and freed at least 150 people [2].
