## World News

Russia and the US agreed to work toward ending the war in the Ukraine [1]. This comes as Russia continues to pressure the Ukraine. Case in point, on February 22, Russia launched an estimated 267 drones into the Ukraine [2]. On February 25, Russian missiles were detected in western Ukraine [3]. On February 28, Ukraine President Zelenskyy got into a live broadcast heated debate in the White House [4]. As a consequence, President Trump suspended military aid to the Ukraine [5]. Additionally, the US cut off providing the Ukraine with intelligence information [6].

In the Congo, reports that the Rwanda-backed rebels, M23, are advancing toward a third city, Butembo (a city of 150,000 people) [7]. Elsewhere in Africa, in the Sudan, reports indicate the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF) executed 200 villagers [8].

In Asia, China is demonstrating its military might. For instance, in a live five exercise near New Zealand, Chinese warships demonstrated advanced weapons [9]. The three Chinese warships conducted live fire exercises much further south than before; offering only hours' notice [10]. Airline pilots were in the air and had to divert flights because of the Chinese live fire [11]. This comes as China announced plans to increase its military budget by 7.2% [12]. One report indicates Elbridge Colby, the nominee for undersecretary of defense for policy, warned we must prepare for a conflict with China over Taiwan [13].

# Middle-East War

The ceasefire between Israel and Hamas continues to hold. For example, Hamas returned the bodies of four hostages [1]. Meanwhile, there are still 59 hostages held by Hamas [2]. In response, President Trump is taking a more direct approach to settling the conflict [3]. Reports indicate he has entered into direct negations with Hamas [4].

The situation in Syria remains volatile. Case in point, approximately 130 people were killed in two-days of fighting between

Syrian and Assad's Alawite sect forces [5]. The Syrian forces are accused of killing civilians from the Alawite religious minority [6]. One report puts the number of dead people above 1,000
